COOKE, Lt. Vincent Joseph. M.C. 7th Bn. Middlesex Regiment. Died of wounds (gas) 1st March, 1921. Age 27. Son of Matthew William and Katherine Cooke of St. Annes, Shrewsbury.



DUNCAN, Lt. Herbert Richard. Royal Army Service Corps. Died 26th April 1919. Age 39. Son of Mr. W.T. and Mrs. S.E. Duncan, of Rydal Mount, Weybridge.



EDWARDS, Capt. Cyril Henry M.B.B.S. London, M.R.C.S., L.R.C.P., L.D.S., R.C.S. Royal Army Medical Corps. Born 7th May 1890. Died 27th August 1920.



JINKS, Mary. Nurse. Territorial Force Nursing Service. Miss Mary Jinks, Assistant Nurse, attached to the 2nd Northern General Hospital (Tor-Na-Dee). Died 29th September 1919 of Tuberculosis. Her next of kin was Mrs Ann Jinks,

65 Millgate, Selby, Yorkshire.



MACDONALD, Lt. Somerled. 1st 54th Sikhs (Frontier Force), Indian Army. Died 30th Nov 1919, age 26. Son of William John Macdonald and of Alexes Macmillan Macdonald.



MENNIE, John Anderson, Staff-Serjeant. Royal Army Service Corps. Died 17th February 1920.



ROCHE, Maj. C. M.C. and Bar. Royal Army Medical Corps. 14th March 1921.
